

# टोतो, ·पितो·, ·प्रितो·

Day 11

## Short & Long i

- टोतो - Read the short i and long i as you would when reading Nepali.

If the first syllable of a word has an i, it is always a short i.	·मि, ·मि·, मिङ, पिप, रिप, किप, तितीङ
All other syllables have the long i.	·सिकी, फिचेरी, तिडी
**The only exception is if there is an आ- negative prefix a before the word. If so, the i is still written as a short i.	·आपितो, आखिप·, आशियप.

- पितो· - Say the following words outloud (be sure to notice the tone dots): ·मि, ·मि·, ·सिकी, फिचेरी, तिडी, किमीरी, ·आपितो
- प्रितो· - Write the words above a few times each. Write down other Nyeshangte words with the short and long i.
